IG-Touch Interactive Panel



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The Panel's Key Functions

Function	Description
USB Ports	There are 5 USB-A ports on the FX panel. Two are on the front bottom right-hand corner of the panel, and three are located on the bottom right-hand side.
	A USB-C port is located on the front bottom right-hand corner of the panel.
Secondary Switch	The secondary power switch is located under the panel.
Power Button	Once the secondary power switch has been turned on, firmly press the button on the right- hand side of the panel to turn it on.
	A <u>White</u> light indicates the panel is turned on and a <u>Red</u> light indicates the panel is off.
	If the button is flashing <u>white</u> and <u>red</u> , the display is off, however the system is in standby mode.
Remote Control	Ensure the remote is pointed directly at the sensor located on the bottom right-hand corner of the panel.
	The colour buttons in the centre of the remote can be used to:
	 Red - Enable or Disable the Front Button and the Touch. Green - Enable or Disable the Front Button. Yellow - Enable or Disable Touch. Blue - Pop out or close the screen freezing tools.
Panel Pens	Two pens are supplied with the panel and can be used simultaneously.
External Inputs	Connect an external PC/Mac/iPad/Tablet on the lower right-hand side.



Home Screen

The Home Screen displays when the panel is turned on and features four applications: Note (Whiteboard), Finder (File Management), Screen Share and a Browser.

The current date and time display in the panel's centre and icons are conveniently displayed in the top right-hand side:

- Hotspot
- Ethernet
- Wi-Fi
- And a USB (if inserted).



Screen Sidebars

Identical screen Sidebars are located in the middle of both the left-hand and right-hand sides of the panel. Touch either arrow to display the Sidebar functions.





Sidebar Functions

Applications on the panel can be accessed via the Sidebars.

The Sidebars have three sections:

- 1. Android Control
- 2. Applications
- 3. Tools

Section 1 – Android Control

Section 1 contains three icons which control the movement on the panel.

Note

Note is an interactive whiteboard application which allows teachers and students to control the panel by touching the screen.

To access Note, select the Note icon located on the Home Screen or on the Sidebar.

6. Pen	 To enable the writing tool, touch the Pen icon. Tap again to open the menu. Select one of the two available pens, the desired colour, line thickness and writing tool.
	The Magic Ward converts a drawn shape into an object.
	 The pens can be flipped to write on either end.
7. Eraser	To access the eraser, touch the Eraser icon. Additional Eraser options are located in Settings.
8. Clean All	To delete all contents on the page, touch the Clean All icon.

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9. Ruler	Touch the Ruler icon to display a variety of measuring tools: a ruler, set squares and a protractor.
10. Shape	 To draw 2D or 3D shapes or lines, touch the Shape icon twice. Select the shape, line and colour. Place the pen in the starting location and drag the shape to the desired size. Use the hand image on the 2D menu to freehand draw 2D shapes.
11. Table	Touch the Table icon to create a table up to 6×6 in size. The height and length of a cell will resize to the size of the cell's contents. Use the Select tool to edit the table.
12. Mind map	Touch the Mind map icon to display a Mind map on the screen. Additional branches can be added.
13. Sticky Notes	 Touch the Sticky Notes icon to display a Sticky Note on the screen. The colour can be changed to Blue, Yellow, Red and Green. Enter the text on the displayed keyboard and press OK. The Sticky Note displays on the upper right-hand side of the page.
14. Preview	To preview the page, touch the Preview icon twice. Use the hand to resize (expand to obtain clarity or reduce to obtain more room) or move the contents of the page.
15. Grid	Touch the Grid icon to display a four lined grid.
16. Undo	To Undo the last action.
17.Redo	To Redo the last action.
18. Add	To Add a new page.
19. Previous	To display the Previous page.
20. Page Number	To display a list of all pages, tap the page numbers. A menu displaying all pages appears on the right-hand side. Touch the page to open that page or X to permanently delete the page.

Finder



Finder is a file management application used to access DOCX, PPTX, XLSX, PDF, audio and video files stored on the panel (Storage) or USB. USBs can be inserted into one of the ports on the bottom right-hand corner or right-hand side of the panel.

To open Finder, touch the **Finder** icon on the Home screen or in Section Two on the Sidebars. The default folders will display. These folders cannot be removed. Additional folders can be added by touching the **new** folder icon on the toolbar.

Tool	Description
Top Menu	 Use the top menu to display documents, Whiteboard files (Note), pictures, audio and video files.
Refresh	Refresh the file search.
Search Files	• Touch the Magnify tool on the top right-hand side of the screen.
	 Enter the filename from the pop-up keyboard.
Select Files	 Touch the select icon on the toolbar.
	 Select the file(s) by touching the file or files.



	Once a file(s) is selected, an additional toolbar displays in the bottom middle of the screen. Image: Street of the screen.
Cut/Copy and Paste	 Select the file(s) or folder(s). Touch the cut icon to cut, or Touch the copy icon to copy. On the left-hand side pane, select the location folder: Storage, USB or Cloud Drive. Touch the paste icon to paste.
Delete a File	 Select the file(s) or folder(s) to delete. Touch the delete icon.



More Tools can be accessed on Section Three of the Sidebars.



The following Tools are available:

Tool	Description
Timer	Opens a Countdown Timer. A bell will ring by default when the time is complete, and the timer can be changed to display the full screen.
Stopwatch	Opens a Stopwatch.
Record	Records the movement on the Panel.
Freeze	Freeze freezes the screen. This allows for one application or file to display on the screen and another on a device.
Сгор	The Crop tool is used to crop and save an image projecting on the panel. The full screen or part of the screen can be cropped.
Split screen	The screen can be split into 2 halves to display certain apps.
Camera	Camera takes photos using an attached USB camera.
PollKit	PollKit is an interactive solution for questioning students. Students answer questions by scanning a QR code. The questions can be asked verbally or entered into PollKit and the students answer on their device. Statistics of the results are displayed upon the panel and can be inserted into the Whiteboard.
Fast File Transfer	Scan a QR code to upload files from a device.
Calendar	The Calendar app displays a calendar. Task items can be added to a To-do list.



Touch Overlay	Touch Overlay controls the panel's touch functionality.
ScreenLock	 ScreenLock is used to set or clear a password to access the panel. Note: It is important to remember the password. If it is forgotten, contact IG3's Technical Support on 1800 334 633.

The Floating Tool

The Floating Tool is accessed on most screens by pressing two fingers on the panel. It displays shortcuts to the Home Screen, the Whiteboard (Note), Settings, open Tasks and Annotate.



The second screen allows you to add shortcuts to Applications.





The Floating Tool can be bedded on then top, bottom or sides of the panel for quick access.





Bytello Share (ScreenShare Pro)

Bytello Share is a wireless display solution preloaded and activated on interactive panels. It provides wireless display and touch control for Windows and Mac laptops and desktops, and wireless display for iPads, tablets, and mobile phones.

Up to nine devices can be displayed simultaneously and up to 254 devices can be connected.

Bytello Share requires network access, and all devices must be connected to the same subnet.

There are five main features available with Bytello Share:

- 1. **Screen Sharing** up to nine devices (PC/Mac/Mobiles/Tablets) on an interactive panel at one time.
- 2. **Desktop Sync** to view the panel's contents on a device.
- 3. **Extended Screen mode** to display different applications or files on the panel from a laptop or desktop device.
- 4. **Remote** to control the panel from a mobile device.
- 5. **Screen Copy** to display the panel's contents onto another interactive flat panel (IFP).

Connecting Devices with Cables

Laptops or desktop computers can be connected to the panel using the supplied cables:

- HDMI
- USB-A to USB-B


VGA Connection

If connecting using a VGA cable, an additional audio cable is also required. To connect successfully, the supplied USB-A to USB-B cable is also needed to enable panel's touch feature. The cable ports are located on the lower right-hand side of panel and are clearly labeled.



HDMI Connection

If connecting with the HDMI cable, the USB-A to USB-B cable is also needed to enable the panel's touch feature. The cable ports are located on the lower right-hand side of panel and are clearly labeled.






Using Finger or Panel's Pen

The Interactive Panel is a 20 point-touch screen.

Both the finger and the pens can be used to access applications, write text, draw, and select objects.

When using the pen, keep it at a right angle to the screen.



Cleaning the Panel

Maintaining and cleaning your panel can avoid many early faults and keep the panel looking like new. Overtime, the interactive panel will accumulate finger marks on the screen from regular use.

Cleaning the Screen

It is important to implement regular cleaning routines:

- 1. Use a microfiber cloth.
- 2. Dampen the cloth with warm water.
- 3. Twist the cloth to completely remove all moisture before wiping the screen
- 4. Wipe in a horizontal motion.
- 5. Ensure all parts of the frame are covered.
- 6. Use a dry microfiber cloth to dry the screen.

Do NOT use chemicals or liquid/water to clean the panel as this will eventually wear down or ruin the anti-glare glass.

Cleaning the Frame

Regularly dust the panel with a dry microfiber cloth to keep it dust free.



Appendix A – Bytello Share (ScreenShare Pro)

Bytello Share is a wireless display solution preloaded and activated on interactive panels. It provides wireless display and touch control for Windows and Mac laptops and desktops, and wireless display for iPads, tablets, and mobile phones.

Up to nine devices can be displayed simultaneously and up to 254 devices can be connected.

Bytello Share requires network access, and all devices must be connected to the same subnet.

There are five main features available with Bytello Share:

- 1. Screen Sharing up to nine devices (PC/Mac/Mobiles/Tablets) on an interactive panel at one time.
- 2. **Desktop Sync** to view the panel's contents on a device.
- 3. **Extended Screen mode** to display different applications or files on the panel from a laptop or desktop device.
- 4. **Remote** to control the panel from a mobile device.
- 5. **Screen Copy** to display the panel's contents onto another interactive flat panel (IFP).

Accessing Bytello Share on the Panel

Bytello Share is accessed via the Floating window on the panel's Home screen.

To access Bytello Share:

- 1. Tap the Floating window on the panel's Home screen.
- 2. Tap View the main interface.



**Note: The Floating window can be moved across the top of the panel.



Updating Bytello Share's Settings

Bytello Share's settings can be updated to suit the organisation's requirements.

To update Bytello Share's settings:

- 1. Open Bytello Share on the panel (refer to page 23).
- 2. Tap **Menu** in the lower left-hand side of the window.



3. Tap **Settings** to display the Settings dialog box. The following settings can be updated:

Field Name	Description
Allow this device to be discovered	Slide to On to allow the panel to be discovered by any device running Bytello Share.
	A prompt will appear suggesting permission mode be turned on at the same time to prevent screen random casting.
Permission Mode	When enabled, any device wishing to access the panel must be either accepted or rejected by the presenter.
Support Chromecast device	Slide to On to allow a device to directly connect to the panel using Chromecast.
	Note: Touch is not supported with Chromecast devices.
Support Airplay device	Slide to On to allow a device to directly connect to the panel using Apple Airplay.
	Note: Touch is not supported with Airplay devices.



Support Miracast device	 Slide to On to allow Intel devices running Windows to directly connect to the panel using Miracast. On the device: Click Notifications in the bottom right- hand corner. Select Project. Click Connect to a Wireless Display. Note: Touch is not supported with Miracast devices.
Device Name	Bytello Share's device name for the panel. This name can be changed.
Start automatically on boot	Bytello Share starts automatically when the panel is booted. Slide to Off if Bytello Share is not required.
Code refresh rate	The Code refresh rate is the time the connection code refreshes. The options are 10 minutes, 20 minutes, 30 minutes, 60 minutes and Never. When the code is set to Never, it permanently remains the same. Setting the code to Never is recommended.
Floating window size	The size of the Floating window can be set to Normal (default), Mini (displays a symbol) or Close. If set to Close, Bytello Share must be manually opened to display the code.
Product User Experience Plan	Sends usage information to the panel's manufacturer. This setting is turned off by default.



Using Bytello Share with a Laptop / Desktop

Laptop and Desktop devices use Bytello Share to connect wirelessly with the panel.

There are three available functions:

- 1. Screen Sharing
- 2. Desktop Sync
- 3. Extended Screen mode

Installing Bytello Share on a Laptop / Desktop Device

Bytello Share requires network access and loads automatically when the panel is turned on. Bytello Share must be installed on all devices connecting to the panel.

To install Bytello Share on a laptop / desktop device:

- 1. Open Bytello Share on the panel (refer to page 23).
- 2. Tap User Guide in the lower right-hand side of the Bytello Share's main interface.



3. On the laptop or desktop, enter **https://ssp.bytello.com/download** into a browser.


4. Bytello Share installs and places an icon onto the device's desktop.

Connecting the Panel and a Laptop / Desktop Device

To connect:

- 1. Open Bytello Share on the device.
- 2. On the laptop / desktop device, enter the 6-digit connection code displayed on the panel.



3. The panel and the laptop / desktop are connected.



Displaying Connected Devices

The presenter controls which connected devices project onto the panel.

To select a device:

1. Tap **Devices** on the lower left-hand side of the Bytello Share's main interface.


Screen Sharing

Screen Sharing projects the contents of a laptop or desktop onto the panel. Applications, documents, pictures, videos, and audio can be projected. Laptop and desktop devices use touch on the panel to control what is projecting.

Up to nine devices can be displayed on the panel at any one time.

To share a laptop or desktop's screen on the panel:

- 1. Connect the panel and the laptop / desktop device (refer to page 27).
- 2. On the laptop or desktop, select Start on the Screen Share option.




- 3. Select **Desktop** or a specific window to mirror.
- 4. Click Mirror.

5. On the panel, if Settings > Permission Mode has been turned on, either **Accept or Reject** the device. While waiting for the presenter to accept the request, a pop-up message displays on the user's device allowing the request to be cancelled.



6. The laptop or desktop's screen contents are mirrored onto the panel.


To stop screen sharing:

1. On the laptop or desktop device, hover the mouse over the Bytello Share control bar in the top center of the screen,

or,

on the panel, tap the Bytello Share control bar.

- 2. The Mirroring toolbar displays.
- 3. Select Close.



- 4. On the laptop or desktop device, click the **Disconnect** icon on the top righthand side.
- 5. Close Bytello Share by clicking on the **X** in the top right-hand corner of the Bytello Share's sign-in screen on the laptop / desktop device.




Desktop Sync

Desktop Sync projects the contents of the panel's screen onto a laptop or desktop device.

To project the panel's screen:

- 1. Connect the panel and the laptop / desktop device (refer to page 27).
- 2. On the device, click Start on the Desktop Sync option.



- On the panel, if Settings > Permission Mode has been turned on, the receiver can either Accept or Reject the device. While waiting for the presenter to accept the request, a pop-up message displays on the user's device allowing the request to be cancelled.
- 4. The panel's screen display is projected onto the device.





- 5. A prompt will appear stating if Touch is required on the device, it must be authorised on the panel by the presenter.
- 6. To authorise Touch, open Bytello Share on the Panel.
 - i. Click **Devices** on the lower left-hand side of the main interface.
 - ii. Tap the **Hand** icon on the Device management window.
 - iii. Tap Authorize to confirm.
 - iv. The laptop / desktop device can now control the panel via a mouse or touchscreen.

7. An Annotation toolbar is available on the panel. It is indicated by a pen to the right of the Floating window on the top of the panel and can be accessed on both the panel and the device.



8. Tap the pen to display the Annotation toolbar (refer to page 45).



To stop syncing:

1. On the laptop or desktop, device, click the **X** in the top right-hand corner of the panel's display.



- 2. On the laptop or desktop device, tap the **Disconnect** icon on the top righthand side.
- 3. Close Bytello Share by clicking on the **X** in the top right-hand corner of the Bytello Share's Sign-in screen on the laptop / desktop device.



Extended Screen Mode

Extended Screen Mode projects a file or an application onto the panel and a different file or an application on the laptop or desktop device.

To run extended screen mode:

- 1. Connect the panel and the laptop / desktop device (refer to page 27).
- 2. On the laptop or desktop, select Start on the Screen Share option.

- 5. On the panel, if Settings > Permission Mode has been turned on, the presenter can either **Accept or Reject** the device. While waiting for the presenter to accept the request, a pop-up message displays on the user's device allowing the request to be cancelled.
- 6. The second screen displays on the panel.
- 7. On the laptop or desktop device, open the file or application to display on the panel.
- 8. Drag the file or application up from the device (first screen) onto the panel (second screen).

To stop extended screen mode:

- 1. On the laptop or desktop device, hover the mouse over the Bytello Share Mirroring control bar in the top center of the screen.
- 2. The Mirroring toolbox displays.
- 3. Click Close.

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- 4. On the laptop or desktop device, tap the **Disconnect** icon on the top righthand side.
- 5. Close Bytello Share by clicking on the **X** in the top right-hand corner of the Bytello Share's sign-in screen on the laptop / desktop device.

Note: The Extended Screen Mode option is only available on laptops or desktops.



Using Bytello Share with a Mobile Device

Bytello Share connects mobile phones, iPads, and tablets to the panel.

There are seven available functions:

- 1. Screen share (Device Mirroring)
- 2. Media
- 3. Photo
- 4. Document (not available on an Apple mobile device)
- 5. Camera
- 6. Remote
- 7. Desktop Sync

Note: The screenshots were captured on an Android mobile phone. Screen displays and some action steps may vary slightly.

Installing Bytello Share on a Mobile Device

Bytello Share requires network access and loads automatically when the panel is turned on. Bytello Share must be installed on all devices connecting to the panel.

To install Bytello Share on a Mobile device:

- 1. Open Bytello Share on the panel (refer to page 23).
- 2. Tap **User Guide** in the lower right-hand side of the Bytello Share's main interface.



3. On a mobile device, scan the QR code or download Bytello Share (ScreenShare Pro) from the App Store.

Screen share


Screen share mirrors the display of a mobile device onto the panel.

To share a device's screen:

1. When the panel and the mobile device are connected (refer to page 35), select **Start** to start sharing the device's display onto the panel.

2. A pop-up dialog box displays confirming Bytello Share will display the contents of the device onto the panel.




- 3. Click START NOW.
- 4. On the panel, if Settings > Permission Mode has been turned on, either Accept or Reject the device. While waiting for the presenter to accept the request, a pop-up message displays on the user's device allowing the request to be cancelled.
- 5. The contents of the mobile device are mirrored onto the panel.



To stop screen sharing:

- 1. On the mobile device, return to the Bytello Share's main interface.
- 2. Tap the **Close** icon on the left of the Screen Share option.






Media

The Media icon plays a video or audio file stored on the mobile device onto the panel.

To play a media file:

1. On the mobile device, tap **Media** on the Bytello Share's main interface.



- 2. Select the Video or Audio tab displayed on the top of the screen.
- 3. Select the media file to play on the panel.
- 4. On the panel, if Settings > Permission Mode has been turned on, either Accept or Reject the device. While waiting for the presenter to accept the request, a pop-up message displays on the user's device allowing the request to be cancelled.
- 5. To stop playing, tap **Stop**.
- 6. Tap the back arrow in the top left-hand side to return to the Bytello Share's main interface.




Photo

The Photo icon projects a photo from the mobile device's photo gallery onto the panel.

To project a photo:

1. On the mobile device, tap **Photo** on the Bytello Share's main interface.



- 2. The device's photo gallery displays.
- 3. Select the photo to project.
- 4. On the panel, if Settings > Permission Mode has been turned on, either Accept or Reject the device. While waiting for the presenter to accept the request, a pop-up message displays on the user's device allowing the request to be cancelled.
- 5. To stop projecting the photo onto the panel, tap the back arrow in the top-left hand side of the mobile device to return to the device's photo gallery.
- 6. Tap it again to return to the Bytello Share's main interface.



Document

DOC, PPT, XLS and PDF documents can be displayed from the mobile device onto the panel.

Note: This function is not available on an Apple device.

To display a document:

1. On the mobile device, tap **Document** on the Bytello Share's main interface.

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- 2. A list of documents displays.
- 3. Tap **Mirror** to the right of the preferred document to display.
- 4. On the panel, if Settings > Permission Mode has been turned on, either Accept or Reject the device. While waiting for the presenter to accept the request, a pop-up message displays on the user's device allowing the request to be cancelled.
- 5. The document displays on the panel in WPS Office.
- 6. The Remote function is enabled on the mobile device to manage the document. (Refer to page 43)
- 7. Tap the back arrow in the top left-hand side to return to the Bytello Share's main interface.




Camera

Selecting the camera icon allows the mobile device 's camera take a photo and project it directly onto the panel.

To take a photo:

1. On the mobile device, tap **Camera** on the Bytello Share's main interface.



- 2. The device's camera is activated.
- 3. Tap the red circular button in the bottom center of the device to project the device's display onto the panel.
- 4. On the panel, if Settings > Permission Mode has been turned on, either Accept or Reject the device. While waiting for the presenter to accept the request, a pop-up message displays on the user's device allowing the request to be cancelled.
- 5. Tap the red square button in the bottom center of the device to take a photo. The photo will display on the panel.
- 6. Continue taking photos.
- 7. Tap again to take another photo or tap **Cancel** to return to Bytello Share's main interface.

Note: The photos are not saved in the device's photo gallery.




Remote

Remote allows the mobile device to act like a mouse and control the panel.

To activate the remote:

1. On the mobile device, tap **Remote** on the Bytello Share's main interface.



- On the panel, if Settings > Permission Mode has been turned on, either Accept or Reject the device. While waiting for the presenter to accept the request, a pop-up message displays on the user's device allowing the request to be cancelled.
- 3. The Remote function opens on the mobile device.

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- 4. The mobile device displays two available options on the bottom of the screen:
 - Left the device acts like a left-hand button on a mouse.
 - **Back** returns to the panel's Home screen.

Double-click the Left option to activate an action.

- 5. The center of the device's display is used as a mousepad.
- 6. Tap the back arrow in the top left-hand side of the mobile device to return to the Bytello Share's main interface.




Desktop Sync

Desktop Sync projects the contents of the panel's display onto a mobile device.

To project the panel's screen:

1. On the mobile device, tap **Desktop Sync** on the Bytello Share's main interface.



- 2. On the panel, either **Accept or Reject** the device if Settings > Permission Mode has been turned on. While waiting for the presenter to accept the request, a popup message displays on the user's device allowing the request to be cancelled.
- 3. The panel's display is mirrored onto the mobile device.

To disconnect Desktop Sync:

1. Tap the **Close** icon on the upper right-hand corner of the mobile device to return to the Bytello Share's main interface.





Disconnecting the Panel and a Mobile Device

To disconnect the mobile device from the panel:

1. On the mobile device's Bytello Share main interface, tap the **Disconnect** icon in the top right-hand corner.

2. The Bytello Share's sign in screen displays on the mobile device.



3. Close Bytello Share on the device.



Annotation Toolbar

When using Desktop Sync, the presenter can annotate on the panel using the Annotation toolbar. A pen displays to the right of the Floating window in the top center of the panel.

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Tap the pen on the panel or on the device, to open the Annotation toolbar.



There are six available functions:

- 1. **Pen** a choice of eight different colours red, yellow, blue, green, purple, black, orange, aqua.
- 2. Eraser erases annotations.
- 3. Clean removes all annotations.
- 4. Save saves the screen display as a jpg onto the panel.
- 5. **Insert** saves the screen display and inserts it into Note (the whiteboard application).
- 6. **Share** sends the screen display to any device connected to the panel. The receiver can accept, reject, and save the image.



Projecting from Panel to Panel

Screen Copy copies one panel's display onto the display of another panel. Both panels must be running Bytello Share.

To share a panel's display:

- 1. Start Bytello Share on both panels.
- 2. Tap Menu > Screen Copy on both panels.

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- 3. On the projecting (main) panel, tap **Start sharing**.
- 4. Tap **Confirm** to share the screen with other IFP devices.

- 5. On the receiving panel, tap **Join Now.**
- 6. On the receiving panel, enter the connection code from the projecting panel.
- 7. Tap Connect.
- 8. The contents of the projecting panel are displayed on the receiving panel.

To stop sharing:

- 1. On the projecting panel, open the Floating window.
- 2. Tap View the main interface.
- 3. Tap **Menu.**
- 4. Tap End sharing on the projecting panel.

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
